Preschool Termly Themes: - Maths/Literacy/Understanding the World

Lisa (Maths): we are settling in new starters and also linking maths with number puzzles/games, 3D shapes, sizes. Walk around estate to look for numbers/shapes, what's in the bag linking numbers songs/rhymes. Linking new starts with me and my family by bringing in pictures of family in.

Jane (Literacy); familiar stories and rhymes. Books to go home to share with parents. Mark-making tools. Letters in our environment. Linking speech and language; who, what, where, why and how questions. Character storytelling eg. 3 bears/3 pigs. Linking speech and communication literacy and maths. We are going on a bear hunt; linking action words, positional language - letter/word sounds.

Ashlee (Understanding the World); during this term we will explore different job roles. If you have a profession you would like to talk the children about please speak to your child's keyperson to book in a date. We will be looking at how plants grow and what happens if they do not have what they need to grow. We will be holding a stay and play for Mother's Day on 20th March.
